General Rules

1. That the club be called FINSBURY PARK CYCLING CLUB.
2. That the object be to promote the sport and pastime of cycling.
3. That the uniform of the club shall consist of ordinary cycling costume, together with the club badge. Club colours to be silver grey and crimson.
4. That the club be managed by an Executive consisting of Officers and a Committee of five other members.
 - 4.(1)** The officers shall be Captain, General Secretary, Time Trials Secretary, Treasurer, Chairman of Committee, Communications Secretary, Road Race Secretary, Track Secretary, Vice Captain, Membership Secretary and Medals Secretary.
 - 4.(2)** The President and Vice Presidents to be members of the Executive; ex-officio.
 - 4.(3)** All officers and members of the Committee shall be deemed to be acting in an honorary capacity.
 - 4.(4)** Other officers (who shall not be entitled to a seat on the Committee by virtue of their office), shall be Time Keeper(s), Newsletter Editor, Cyclo Cross Secretary, Curator, Social Secretary, Assistant Time Trials Secretary and Assistant Road Racing Secretary. The latter two officers may attend Committee meetings in lieu of their principals.
 - 4.(5)** Executive meetings shall be held each month, a quorum to consist of not less than one third of the officers and committee eligible to attend such meetings.
 - 4.(6)** That if any member of the Committee be absent from three consecutive meetings, that seat shall be vacant unless satisfactory reasons be given; and the Committee shall have full powers to fill any vacancy that may occur.
5. The offices of President and Vice Presidents shall be filled each AGM. Existing holders may be re-elected without prior nomination. New nominations shall be delivered in writing to the Hon. Gen Secretary not later than 31st December prior to the AGM.
 - 5.(1)** The President and Vice Presidents shall be deemed Honorary Members for the period of office.
 6. That the annual subscription (falling due on the 1st January each year) shall be £20, except for 2nd claim and juniors (anyone below the age of 18 years on the date the subscription is due) where it will be £15.00.
 - 6.(1)** First year's subscription to be sent with form of application for membership.
 - 6.(2)** Any member elected after October 1st shall not be liable for an annual subscription for the following year.
 7. That members with forty years continuous membership shall be offered honorary membership. In exceptional circumstances the AGM shall have the power to elect Honorary Members.
 - 7.(1)** Honorary Members are not liable for subscription.
 8. That the Executive Committee shall establish and publish at the start of the year, a schedule of regular riding runs and other riding fixtures.
 9. That prospective members, new to cycling, must have attended official club runs or other riding fixtures on at least three occasions (or, alternatively, not less than five club fixtures, of which at least two shall be riding fixtures prior to their election, and shall be proposed and seconded by two

members on the form provided, and elected by ballot of the Executive Committee; three adverse votes to exclude.

9.(1) An established cyclist, known to club members and wishing to become a member, shall be proposed and seconded by two members on the form provided, and elected by ballot of the Executive Committee; three adverse votes to exclude.

9.(2) A prospective member being the partner, spouse or relative of a member, and being introduced by such a member shall be proposed and seconded by two members on the form provided, and elected by ballot of the Executive Committee; three adverse votes to exclude.

10. No member shall be allowed to compete for any award unless they shall have paid their subscription for the current year. In the event of any member, whose subscription shall not have been paid, so competing, they shall be disqualified and their entry fee shall be forfeited.

11. Any member wishing to resign must notify their intention in writing to the Hon Gen Secretary before the AGM in each year, otherwise they shall become liable for their subscription for the ensuing year. Any member one year in arrears with subscription shall be notified that unless such subscription be paid to date, membership of the Club shall be cancelled.

11.(1) The Committee will exercise discretion in special cases.

12. In the event that any member being considered by a majority vote at a Committee meeting to be guilty of violation of Club Rules or have seriously prejudiced the prestige of the Club or the good fellowship of its members, the Committee shall have the power to expel such member. A member's expulsion however, shall not become absolute until 14 days after the meeting at which their expulsion is passed by the Committee, during which time they may appeal to a Special General Meeting of the Club as provided in Rule 16. In the event of a Special General Meeting being called for this purpose, the expulsion shall not become absolute until the meeting has been held or until the lapse of 14 days, whichever is later.

13. No officer or any member of the Committee shall hold office in any other Metropolitan cycling club.

14. The Captain, or in their absence, the Vice Captain shall have entire control of the club runs.

15. That the AGM be held within four months of the end, or at the discretion of the committee, of the financial year, to receive reports of the Honorary General Secretary, Captain, Time Trials Secretary, Track Secretary, Road Racing Secretary, Social Secretary, Membership Secretary and Balance Sheet, to appoint officers and committee for the ensuing season, and to transact any other business that may become necessary. The notice convening the AGM shall be circulated to all members four weeks prior to the date of such meeting.

16. A Special General Meeting shall be summoned by the Hon Gen Secretary on receiving a requisition, stating the object thereof, and signed by not less than six members. Such requisition shall be accompanied by a deposit of one pound sterling, which deposit shall be forfeited if the meeting shall consider the reason for convening it to be frivolous.

16.(1) In the case of special urgency, the Chairman of Committee and Secretary shall have power to convene a General Meeting.

17. That no Rule be made, altered or rescinded, except at a General Meeting, when notice of such intention has been given to each member, and then by the vote of a two thirds majority of the members voting. Not less than ten members personally present shall constitute a quorum at a General Meeting.

- 18.** Members to be notified of the agenda for any General Meeting a week prior to such meeting, those unable to attend to be allowed to vote by proxy on any business advertised. Proxies to be delivered to the Hon Gen Secretary before the meeting.
- 19.** The Executive shall have the powers to deal with disputed points not otherwise provided for in these Rules.
- 20.** A first claim member is one who, at the time of the election, was a member of no other cycling club, or who has since the date of their election resigned membership of those clubs of which they was a member at the time of the election.
- 21.** The club shall permit second claim membership
- 22.** A Junior is one who has not attained the age of eighteen, as follows:
 - 22.(1)** For liability for first subscription, on the date of valid application for election or 1st January for subsequent subscriptions;
 - 22.(2)** For the Junior Championship, and other awards, on 1st January each year.
 - 22.(3)** For other purposes, on the date of the fixture or function.
- 23.** That any member bringing a guest(s) to the Clubroom be charged the Clubroom fee for each guest.
- 24.** Upon a resolution to dissolve the club, taken at a general meeting or special general meeting convened under rule 16 or 16(1), dissolution shall be managed in strict accordance with guidelines issued by CASC (Community Amateur Sports Clubs), or its equivalent at that time. That no person being a club member, family or associate of a club member shall benefit from dissolution of the club.

Duties of Club Officials

Captain

To have entire control of club runs (Rule 14). To make arrangements for Club tours and special fixtures. To keep a record of attendance on all Club runs and fixtures. To furnish a report to the AGM,

Vice Captain

To assist the Captain to carry out their directions and act for them in their absence.

Honorary Secretary

To prepare the agenda and keep records in the Club minute book of the proceedings of all committee meetings and general meetings and make all other necessary arrangements in connection therewith. To attend to the Club correspondence except where otherwise specified. To prepare and present to the AGM a report of the Club's activities during the past year.

Honorary Treasurer

To receive all monies due to the Club. To pay all bills and accounts passed by the Committee. To obtain receipts and vouchers for all expenditure. To keep a permanent record of the above in a cash book or ledger. To prepare an annual cash statement and balance sheet and furnish to the honorary auditors all necessary books, papers and information to enable same to be certified.

Honorary Time Trials Secretary

To deal with all correspondence and other matters relating to road time trials and to furnish a report to the AGM.

Track Secretary, Road Race Secretary and Cyclo Cross Secretary

To deal with all matters relating to track, road racing and cyclo cross and to furnish reports to the AGM.

Newsletter Editor and Communications Secretary

To publish the monthly newsletter and ensure all requisite publicity in the cycling and general press.

Membership Secretary

To act as a conduit between new and prospective members and the club, explain the application process and support applications from new members, liaise with other club officials to ensure club activities support the effective integration of new members into the club and provide an annual report to the AGM.

Social Secretary

To make arrangements for the Annual Dinner, Dances, Clubroom and general social activities. To furnish a report to the AGM.

Medals Secretary

To be responsible for all engraving of medals and trophies. To keep accurate records of the number and type of Club medals in hand and to arrange for the ordering of such medals as and when necessary. To furnish a report to the AGM.

Road Racing and Time Trial Regulations

1. Performances by first claim members shall be open to inclusion as Club records. Successive performances recognised as beating existing Club records shall appear in the Handbook.
2. Where a Club record is established for a distance or type of machine for which records have not previously been recognised, performances must beat the time or distance limit set for new records. No ride can be approved as a Club record if the performance antedates the recognition of such records. Women's bicycle records shall be similarly recognised but to qualify for a record badge or special prize the performance shall beat the Silver Standard for the distance.
3. A record badge or special prize will be awarded to each member, who on 1st November shall have broken any Club record during the current year. Bronze medals will be awarded to each team, who on 1st November shall have broken any Club team record during the current year. The fastest three rides in an open, semi-open or inter/ club event shall be recognised to constitute a team for this purpose.
4. The Club will present to any member breaking an N & W, HC RRA or RRA record a special plaque or award to the value of £10. There will be no limit to the number of awards during any one season.
5. Races and time trials promoted by the Club or in which club members compete shall be conducted in accordance with the regulations of the controlling bodies of the type of event being promoted or competed in.

6. Only first claim members riding in the name of the Club are eligible to compete for Club awards and trophies.
7. A member winning a Club trophy shall be entitled to receive it only after they shall have given a written guarantee for its safe custody and due return in good order and condition. They shall also undertake that it shall not be pledged, pawned or loaned or handed to any third party whatsoever and that it shall not be exhibited for any trade purpose. They shall undertake to return it on demand, in writing, of the Secretary, to them or to any person deputed by them to receive it, within seven days of its demand. If any of the foregoing conditions be broken then the Secretary shall have power to demand the immediate return of the trophy.
8. Only those members who are amateur cyclists shall be entitled to receive Club medals, prizes or trophies, or to compete in Club events. Any breach of regulations shall entitle the Committee to demand the return of any trophy held by the offending member and to withhold any award otherwise due in respect of the event concerned.
- 8.(1)** An amateur is a rider who is recognised as an amateur by the relevant CTT regulations and BC rules of racing.
9. For the purposes of the Club Championships and the award of trophies, medals and prizes, only performances accomplished during the period 1st January to 31st October shall count for the year then current.
10. For the purpose of Club awards, a novice shall be regarded as one who has not, at the commencement of the season, competed in more than two competitive road and/or track events, excluding contests, tourist trials and similar events.
11. All places to count toward the Road and Criterium championships shall be reported to the Road Race Secretary within six weeks of the event. A copy of the start sheet and, if available, the results sheet and or a report from the cycling press on the result should accompany all claims. Any exception to this may only be accepted by the instruction of the committee.

Road Race Points (Amended 2012)

Points awarded to members for road and circuit events shall be equal to the British Cycling points offered for their placing, if it is an event run under British Cycling regulations.

For events not run under British Cycling regulations points shall be based on event distance as follows (points for first place to the final placing, shown in order):

Up to (inc) 50 km:

10,8,7,6,5,4,3,2,1,1

Over 50km and up to (inc) 100 km:

30,25,21,17,14,12,10,8,7,6,5,4,3,2,1

Over 100km and up to (inc) 130km:

60,52,45,40,35,31,27,23,20,17,15,13,11,9,7,6,5,3,2,1

Over 130km, or women-only races over 65km:

100,85,75,66,58,51,45,39,34,29,25,21,18,15,12,10,8,6,4,2

For non-British Cycling multi-stage events, where overall placings are awarded, Finsbury Park points shall be awarded both for individual stages and for overall placing. The latter points are based on the total distance covered in the course of the event.

For age-restricted events such as those open only to juniors or to veterans, points shall be multiplied by 0.5

Points are only awarded for events taking place in the UK

Points are only awarded if gained in competition with at least two other riders of the same category.

For example:

A rider competes in an LVRC event for categories ABC and comes 1st in the A category, but third overall.

If there were two other A category riders competing, the rider can claim points for a 1st place.

If the rider was the only A category competitor, but there were two other non-A category riders, the rider can claim points for a 3rd place.

If there were less than two other competitors the rider may not claim any points.

Cyclo-Cross Regulations

The Committee, in August of each year (or as soon as the Calendar is published), with guidance from Cyclo-Cross Secretary, to select between five and fifteen designated counting races evenly spaced through the Cyclo-Cross season (September 1st – August 31st).

Points

Points to be awarded to FPCC finishers as follows: 100 points for 1st Place overall, 99 for 2nd, 98 for 3rd 97 for 4th etc.....down to 1 point.

Depending on number of designated races selected for the Championship, the best 60% of the possible scores are to be totalled to decide the championship (i.e.: best 3 from 5 races, best 6 from 10 races, best 9 from 15 races etc).

Awards

An award to be made to the winner of the championship (silvered bronze medal).

A runner-up award (bronze medal) to be made if four members take part in any championship races.

In the case of a tie, the champion is the rider with the most "FPCC wins", most seconds, most thirds etc. If all scores are identical the championship to be declared a tie.

Club Event Regulations

1. For Club events (other than 10 mile Time Trial Championship and the Hill Climb) the entrance fee shall be £1.00 plus the CTT levy and the prize list (subject to a minimum entry of five for 25 and 50 miles: if less than minimum, any entries to be handicapped or calculated for the Gordon Stewart Bowl) shall be as follows:

Scratch (all events) - Fastest: Enamelled Bronze medal.

Events up to 50 miles with at least 14 entries - Second fastest: Bronze medal.

Greatest improvement – Entries in events up to 50 miles (subject to a minimum entry of five) the member showing the best improvement over their best performance during the current and last three seasons shall be awarded a Bronze medal in club and inter-club 25/50 mile time trials.

2. Scratch award winners who so qualify will forfeit such improvement award, and no improvement award will be made. No improvement award will be made where no improvement occurs.
3. Entry fee and prize list (if any) for other events shall be fixed by the Executive Committee. Entries to Club events, including payment of entry fee, shall be made to the Time Trials Secretary not less than twelve days before the date of the event.
4. The entrance fee for 10 mile time trials and the Hill Climb shall be £1.00 plus the CTT levy. The prize list for the 10 mile Time Trial Competition awarded on a points system shall be Enamelled Bronze medal for second place and Bronze medal for third place. The awards for the overall scratch 10 mile competition based on the average mph of not less than 50% of the scheduled programme shall be Enamelled Bronze medal for first place and Bronze medal for second place.
5. Members will be allowed to purchase their own handicap or improvement prizes on receipt of official authority from the Time Trials Secretary.
6. Only time trial performances made in events promoted under CTT regulations will qualify for Club Time Trial awards, Club Time Trial Championships and Club Time Trial records.
7. Performances in private time trials do not qualify for inclusion in Club Championships, the Club Handicap (Improvement) Championship, 10's Competition (Points and Scratch sections), and Hill Climb Championship. Private time trials do qualify for all other championships, provided the appropriate club official receives a signed statement from the officiating time keeper.

Track Record Attempts

START. Start timekeeper must be on the start line with watch running and count-down given. No assistance to be given to the rider when starting except holding up.

FINISH. The finish timekeeper must be on the finish line with the same (start) instrument.

TIMING. Must be to an agreed standard (round up to next 5th second) and within capabilities of timekeepers and equipment. Two timekeepers preferred, with slowest time to count. All timekeeper's times to be recorded for transparency.

Standard Distance Regulations

(Revised Feb. 2014)

1. Members can claim one Standard medal for any ride that betters the published standard at that distance (see tables below) during the season.
2. The racing season is January 1st to October 31st. Claims must be submitted to the Medal Secretary by November 30th. Claims must be in writing and accompanied by proof of the result.
3. Only one medal will be awarded per season for each distance based on the member's best performance at that distance.
4. Claims in subsequent years must beat the rider's previous Standard awards to qualify.
5. Claims shall be accompanied by the appropriate fee. This fee is at the discretion of the club committee.

The club will, subject to the regulations above, present to first claim members Standard medals for any rider beating the following standards accomplished before 1st November of any year in the name of FPCC.

Time Trial Awards

The Aleko Cup

Presented by C.A.J.Knife as a perpetual trophy awarded annually to the Junior Champion.

Competition superseded by the Reg Brock Trophy.

From 2003 is awarded annually to the member returning the fastest 10mile-time trial in the season.

The Club presents annually a silvered bronze medal

The Darling-Lauterwasser Cup

Originally presented by C.H.Darling as a 12 hour trophy. Won outright by J.Lauterwasser in 1926 after three wins in succession, and presented by him to the Club as a perpetual trophy awarded annually to the member accomplishing the fastest 50 of the season. The Club presents annually a silvered bronze medal.

The Dunn Trophy

Presented by A.M.M.Dunn, as a perpetual trophy awarded annually to the Club Hill Climb Championship.

The Club presents annually a silvered bronze medal.

Provided there are at least ten qualifiers, the Club will award an enamelled bronze medal for runner up.

The Edrupt Shield

Presented by A and B.Edrupt, as a perpetual trophy. To be awarded annually for the fastest 10 Mile time trial by a woman member.

The Club presents annually a silvered bronze medal

The Frank Tillman Memorial Bowl

Bequeathed by Pilot Officer F.H.Tillman (Polish Cross for Valour) killed on active service 13" January 1944. This perpetual trophy to his memory is awarded annually to the member accomplishing the greatest distance in a 24 hour.

The Club presents annually a silvered bronze medal.

The Gordon Stewart Bowl

Presented by Gordon Stewart as a Handicap Championship Trophy. To be a perpetual trophy awarded annually to the member returning the best handicapped average speed (or best improvement in average speed or nearest thereto compared with previous actual or calculated performances, calculated by the "average of averages" method) in Club or nominated events at 25, 50 and 100 miles.

The Club presents annually a silvered bronze medal.

The John Blunt Cup

Won by J.Lauterwasser in connection with their 100 mile RRA record of 4:13:35 set in 1928 and presented by them to the Club as a perpetual trophy awarded annually to the member accomplishing the fastest 100 of the season.

The Club presents annually a silvered bronze medal.

The Johnson-Hussey Cup

Won by E.W.Hussey in 1937 for three consecutive wins in the annual 100 miles Club event and represented by him to the Club in 1978 as a perpetual trophy. Awarded annually to the member returning the best performances over 10, 25 and 50 miles over two events at each of those distances (6 in total) in club or nominated races. It shall be calculated by the "average of averages" method.

The Club presents annually a silvered bronze medal to the holder.

Subject to there being at least 10 qualifiers, an enamelled bronze medal will be awarded to the runner up and in the event of their being 15 or more qualifiers, a bronze medal will be awarded to the third placed rider.

The Martyn Odam Trophy

Presented as a perpetual trophy in memory of Martyn Odam by Mrs Pam Odam and her family. Awarded annually to the winner of the Club 10 miles road time trial competition.

The Club presents annually a silvered bronze medal.

Points are awarded (from 10 down to 1 to the top 10 finishers) for the best improvement, or nearest, on base time computed each season as follows:

- 1) Fastest time at the distance in the previous year's competition on Club course, or;
- 2) Fastest time two seasons previously, or;
- 3) Fastest time on any course in previous four seasons, plus 30 seconds, or;
- 4) Fastest time ever, plus one minute, or;
- 5) No previous performance. Senior Men - 26:00, Junior Men - 27:00, Ladies - 28:00
- 6) No base time to exceed 30 mins.
- 7) Members qualifying for points in Club 10s will receive the maximum number of points for that position where a tied result occurs.

The Miller Cup

Presented by E.L.Miller as a perpetual trophy awarded annually to the runner up in the annual Touche Championship competition.

The Club presents annually a silvered bronze medal.

Provided there are at least six finishers in the above competition, the Club will award annually an enamelled bronze medal for third place.

The Reg Brock Trophy

Donated by Mrs C.Brock, Friends and Members of the Club as a perpetual trophy awarded annually to the Junior Championship. The competition shall be based on the average of each riders fastest two performances at both 10 and 25 miles in any approved event.

The Club presents annually a silvered bronze medal.

Provided there are at least five qualifiers, the Club will award an enamelled bronze medal for runner up.

The Saward Cup

Presented by W.Saward as a perpetual trophy awarded annually to the member returning the best 12 hour of the season.

The Club presents annually a silvered bronze medal.

The Scales Cup

Presented by W.C.Scales as a perpetual trophy awarded annually to the member returning the fastest 25 of the season.

The Club presents annually a silvered bronze medal.

The Touche Championship Cup

Presented by Club President, Sir George Touche, MP, as a perpetual trophy for the championship of the Club. To be held by the member showing the best average speed for road rides on 'singles' at 25, 50 and 100 miles during the season. From 1978, awarded annually as the Club "Best All Rounder" trophy to the member showing the best average speed for road time trials on a solo bicycle or tricycle in Club, Open and Semi-open events at 25, 50 and 100 miles during the season.

The Club presents annually a silver gilt medal to the holder.

The Veterans Time Trial Shield

To be a perpetual trophy awarded annually to the veteran member with the best aggregate time in any two 10, 25 and 50 miles time trials, including private time trials.

The Club presents a silvered bronze medal.

For the purpose of this competition, a veteran is a member who is aged 40 years or more on the day of competition.

The Women's Championship

The competition is based on each rider's fastest two performances over both 10 and 25 miles (ie four races in total) and shall be calculated by the "average of averages" method.

The Club presents annually a silvered bronze medal.

Provided there are at least five qualifiers, the Club will award an enamelled bronze medal for runner up.

Road Racing Awards

The Clifford Trophy

Presented by R.Clifford, as a perpetual trophy awarded annually to the winner of the Club Road Race Championship. Points are scored as per the Finsbury Park points system for road and closed circuit events. Points gained in criterium events do not count. In stage events, points may be scored in stage sections and final general classification. However, criterium stages and time trial stages/events do not qualify. The Club presents annually a silvered bronze medal.

The Yule Trophy

Presented by I.S.Yule, as a perpetual trophy awarded annually to the winner of the Club Road Race Championship.

From 1993, this trophy is awarded to the Club Road Race Championship runner up. The Club presents annually an enamelled bronze medal.

The Women's Road Race Championship

Conditions applying to the award of this trophy are as per those for the Clifford Trophy.

The Club to award annually a silvered bronze medal to the winner, and an enamelled bronze medal to the runner up.

The Women's Criterium Championship

Conditions for the competition are the same as the Criterium Championship, excepting for the adjustment factor in points gained.

The Club to award annually a silvered bronze medal to the winner, and an enamelled bronze medal to the runner up.

The Road Racing Aspirants Award

The competition is open to any rider who, at the beginning of the season, does not hold or has ever previously held or been eligible to hold either a BC category Elite, 1 or 2 racing license.

The competition shall be based on Finsbury Park points awarded during the season for places gained in open and association road races and criteriums. Places gained in individual stages of stage races, excepting time trials and handicap stages, shall be deemed to count, together with the final overall position on General Classification.

The Club presents annually a silvered bronze medal.

The Criterium Championship

The Championship shall be based on points awarded for places gained in open and association criteriums as per the Finsbury Park points system for road and closed circuit events. Places gained in criterium stages of a stage race shall count towards the criterium championship.

The following will not qualify towards the criterium championship

- Handicap events.
- Road races.

The Club to award annually a silvered bronze medal to the winner, and an enamelled bronze medal to the runner up.

Track Awards

The Stilts Trophy

Presented by V.Stilts as a perpetual trophy awarded annually to the winner of the Club Track Championship who shall be selected by the Committee.

The Club presents annually a silvered bronze medal to the winner and if chosen an enamelled bronze medal to the runner up.

Track Points shall be awarded on the following basis:-

Points are only awarded for the final position in Each Race.

Open Events 6 Points 1st Place, 4 Points 2nd Place, 2 Points 3rd Place.

Track League Events.

Where there are separate events held for different Categories of Riders, Points shall be awarded on the following basis.

The Category is defined by the number of Categories in the league divided by 2. Where an uneven number of categories are available, the rider in the odd middle category shall be placed in the upper category.

Upper Categories 6 Points 1st Place, 4 Points 2nd Place, 2 Points 3rd Place

Lower Categories 3 Points 1st Place, 2 Points 2nd Place, 1 Point 3rd Place.

Merit Awards

The Jack Keen Memorial Bowl

Presented by Mrs W.J.Keen in memory of her son Sergeant-Pilot F.J.Keen, RAF killed on active service 20th June 1942. To be a perpetual trophy awarded annually to the member adjudged the best novice of the year.

The Club presents annually a silvered bronze medal.

The Club Attendance Trophy

Contributed by the Vice Presidents for the best all-round support at Club fixtures each year.

Definition of 'club fixture' and associated points value to be determined by Committee at start of season and list of qualifying events to be circulated to members. The Club presents a silvered bronze medal.

The Club Attendance Trophy R/up

Made and donated by John Kaine. To recognise exceptional support given to club runs leaders and assistance at club fixtures.

The Pontin Shield

To be a perpetual trophy awarded annually by the committee for an outstanding cycling ride or rides in non-competitive or competitive event. The Club presents annually a silvered bronze medal

The Joe Evans Memorial Trophy

Presented as a perpetual trophy in memory of Joe Evans by Mrs Winifred Evans. Awarded annually to the member adjudged by the Committee to have given the most meritorious service to the Club.

The Club presents a silvered bronze medal.

The G. H. Hampton Trophy

Presented in memory of G.H.Hampton by his wife Mrs Alice Hampton. To be a perpetual trophy awarded annually to the member adjudged by the Committee to have made the best contribution to the Club Gazette. The Club presents a silvered bronze medal.
