Course description

Line up in short road opposite Race H/Q. (Neutralized) turn left into school lane and then right into Churchfield Road to turn right on to B1000 (1ml). In 1ml turn left on to B1000. In 0.4ml turn right into Herts Lane to De-neutralize at **start/finish line at 30mph restriction sign**.

Continue on Herts Lane to roundabout 0.1ml and take first exit on to Moors Wlk. Continue on Moors Walk to turn right to Sylvan Way (1.4mls). Turn left on Black Fans road (B195/2mls). Continue on Black Fans road to turn left on slip road at junction with A414, Hertingfordbury Road (2.7mls).

Continue on dual carriageway to next roundabout to Thieves Lane (4.9mls). **(KOM competition will be judged at the 30mph signs just before the roundabout at the top of the hill—white flag.)** At next roundabout take first exit to B1000 (5.5mls). Continue along B1000 to turn left on Herts Lane (8mls) to complete lap (8.3mls).

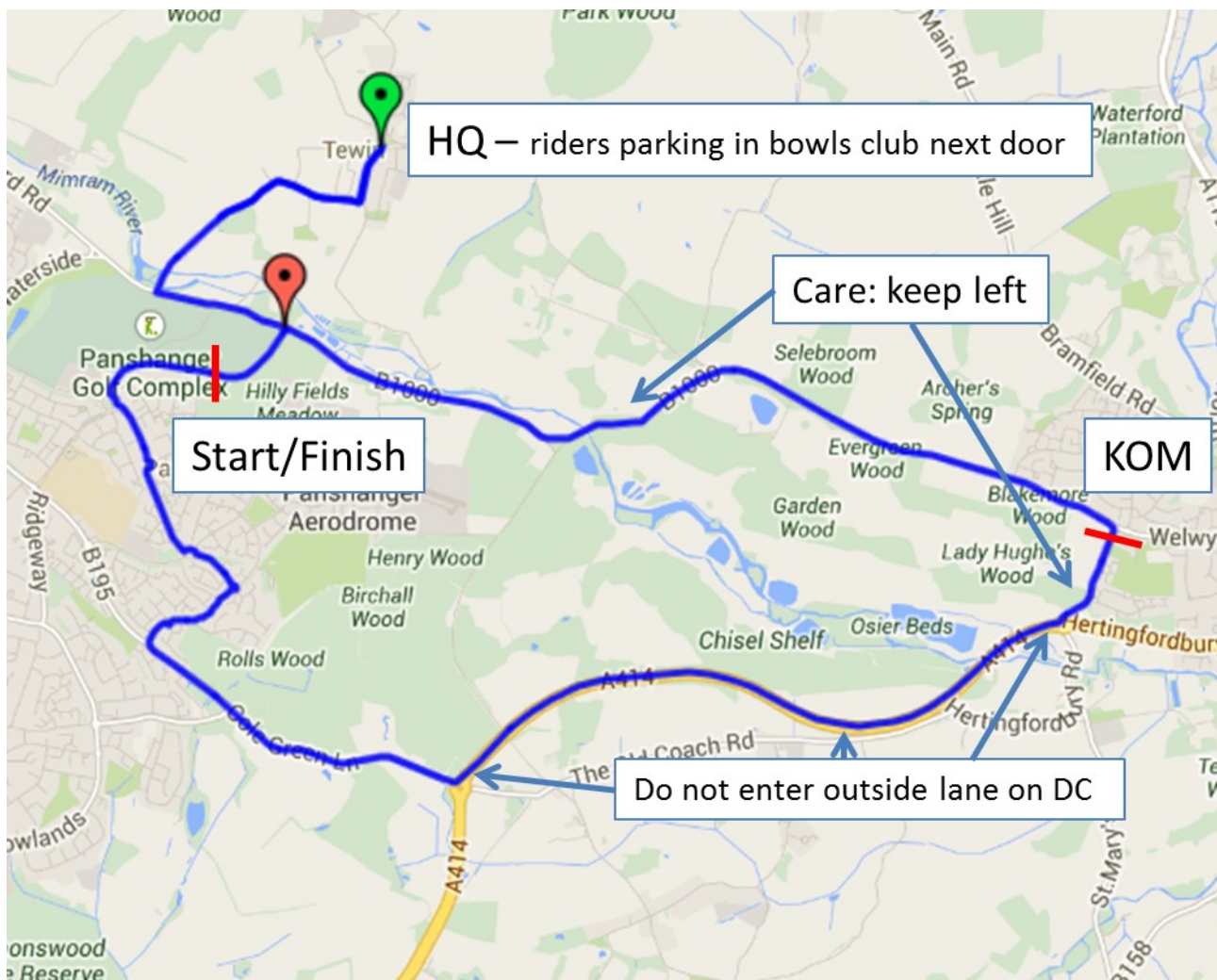
Notes

Extra care when approaching A414, this is a dual carriageway. **Riders must not cross into the 2nd lane or they will be disqualified, no warnings given.**

Care should be taken on the B1000 at the downhill "corkscrew" before the jnc. with Panshanger lane on the left.

Take care on Thieves lane. This is a busy road. Keep to the left. **Any rider over the dashed line at the prime point will not be eligible for points/prizes.**

There are potholes on the single carriageway sections of the course. Please call out to warn other riders of them.



Information for riders

Sign on opens at 7.15am and closes at 8.00am at which time any reserve places will be allocated and entries on the day accepted. Any entry on the day will be available on a first come first served basis at £20. Those seeking entry on the day should approach the signing on desk immediately they arrive.

No licence = day licence for £10 and no points.

Any juniors must report to the assistant commissaire for a gear check at 7.45am.

Race service will be available. Please hand spare wheels, labelled with your name or number to Jeremy or Pete. If you don't hand a wheel in you may get no race service. You may not receive your own wheel and will be responsible for any damage to a spare wheel while you are riding it.

The race convoy will form up outside the village hall and leave at 8.30am. **Please be in place at 8.20am for a riders' briefing.**

Prince of Thieves hill climb competition: Each time over the hill (except the last lap) 1st, 2nd and 3rd place riders score 3,2,1 points.

All prizes must be collected on the day.

Do not throw gel wrappers on the road. Any rider urinating in public or being discourteous to a member of the public will be disqualified and fined regardless of the circumstances.
