

Amendments to Time Trial and Track regulations; proposed by the Committee.

Time Trial Awards

Woman Club BAR - The Women's Championship

2 x 10 miles, 2 x 25 miles times trials, in Club, Open and Semi-open Events.

The competition is based on each rider's fastest two performances over both 10 and 25 miles and shall be calculated by the "average of averages" method. **In the event of no qualifiers, at the Committees discretion the award may be granted to the rider completing 70 miles in Time Trials of any distance, using the same calculation.** The Club also presents annually a silvered bronze medal. Provided there are at least five qualifiers, the Club will award an enamelled bronze medal for the runner up.

Club Handicap Championship Trophy - The Gordon Stewart Bowl

1 x 25 mile, 1 x 50 miles, 1 x 100 miles in Club or Nominated events.

To be a perpetual trophy awarded annually to the member returning the best handicapped average speed in club or nominated events at 25, 50 and 100 miles. Handicap average speed is calculated on best improvement in average speed or nearest thereto compared with previous actual or calculated performances. It is calculated by the "average of averages" method. **In the event of no qualifiers, at the Committees discretion the award may be granted to the rider completing 175 miles in Time Trials of any distance, using the same calculation.**

The Club also presents annually a silvered bronze medal.

Presented by Gordon Stewart as a Handicap Championship Trophy.

Veterans Club BAR - The Veterans Time Trial Shield

2 x 10 miles, 2 x 25 miles, 2 x 50 miles road time trials in **Club, Open and Semi-open Events.**

To be a perpetual trophy awarded annually to the veteran member with the best aggregate time in any two 10, 25 and 50 miles time trials, **in Club, Open and Semi-open Events. In the event of no qualifiers, at the Committees discretion the award may be granted to the rider completing 170 miles in Time Trials of any distance, using the same calculation.** The Club also presents a silvered bronze medal. For the purpose of this competition, a veteran is a member who is aged 40 years or more on the day of competition.

Club BAR, Club and Nominated Events - The Johnson-Hussey Cup

2 x 10 miles, 2 x 25 miles, 2 x 50 miles in club or nominated events.

To be a perpetual trophy awarded annually to the member returning the best performances over 10, 25 and 50 miles over two events at each of those distances. It shall be calculated by the "average of averages" method. **In the event of no qualifiers, at the Committees discretion the award may be granted to the rider completing 170 miles in Time Trials of any distance, using the same calculation.** The Club also presents annually a silvered bronze medal. Subject to there being at least 10 qualifiers, an enamelled bronze medal will be awarded to the runner up. Subject to there being at least 15 or more qualifiers, a bronze medal will be awarded to the third placed rider.

Won by E.W.Hussey in 1937 for three consecutive wins in the annual 100 miles Club event and represented by them to the Club in 1978 as a perpetual trophy.

Club BAR - The Touche Championship Cup

1 x 25 miles, 1 x 50 miles, 1 x 100 miles road time trials in Club, Open and Semi-open Events.

Awarded annually to the member returning the best average speed for road rides on 'singles' at 25, 50 and 100 miles in Club, Open and Semi-open events during the season

From 1978, awarded annually as the Club "Best All Rounder" trophy to the member showing the best average speed for road time trials. on a solo bicycle or tricycle. The Club also presents annually a silver gilt medal.

In the event of no qualifiers, at the Committees discretion the award may be granted to the rider completing 175 miles in Time Trials of any distance, using the same calculation.

Presented by Club President, Sir George Touche, MP, as a perpetual trophy for the championship of the Club.

Club BAR Runner Up - The Miller Cup

1 x 25 miles, 1 x 50 miles, 1 x 100 miles road time trials in Club, Open and Semi-open Events.

Awarded annually to the runner up in the annual Touche Championship competition. **In the event of no qualifiers, at the Committees discretion the award may be granted to the rider completing 175 miles in Time Trials of any distance, using the same calculation.** The Club also presents annually a silvered bronze medal. Provided there are at least six finishers in the Touche Championship, the Club will award annually an enamelled bronze medal for third place.

Presented by E.L.Miller as a perpetual trophy.

Junior BAR Championship - The Reg Brock Trophy

2 x 10 miles, 2 x 25 miles road time trials **in Club, Open and Semi-open Events.**

To be a perpetual trophy awarded annually to the junior member with the best aggregate time in any two 10 and 25 miles time trials, **in Club, Open and Semi-open Events. In the event of no qualifiers, at the Committees discretion the award may be granted to the rider completing 70 miles in Time Trials of any distance, using the same calculation.** The Club also presents a silvered bronze medal. Provided there are at least 5 qualifiers, the Club will also award an enamelled bronze medal for the runner up. For the purpose of this competition, a junior is a member until their 18th birthday and until 31st December of the year in which their 18th birthday occurs.

Track Awards.

Track Championship.

Awarded annually to the winner of the Club Track Championship who shall be selected by the Committee.

The Club presents annually a silvered bronze medal to the winner and if chosen an enamelled bronze medal to the runner up.
